Nurse's Corner

A message from Nurse Brittany



Our school has a written policy to assure the safe administration of medication to students during the school day. If your child must have medication of any type, including over-the-counter drugs, given during school hours, you have the following choices:

- 1) You may come to school and give the medication to your child at the appropriate time(s).
- 2) You may obtain a copy of the medication form from the nurse and take the form to your child's doctor and have him/her complete the form by listing the medication(s) needed, dosage, and number of times per day the medication is to be administered. This form must be completed by the physician for both prescription and over-the-counter drugs. The form must be signed by the doctor and by you, the parent or guardian. Prescription medicines must be brought to school in a pharmacy-labeled bottle which contains instructions on how and when the medication is to be given. Over-the-counter drugs must be received in the original container and will be administered according to the doctor's written instructions.

Please know that any unused medications in the Health-Suite will need to be picked up once the student is completed with the prescription or at the end of the school year, and a new order form will need to be completed each year.

If your child requires an inhaler or an epi-pen at home please ask the doctor for a second inhaler or epi-pen to remain in school for the safety of the child, the weather is becoming cooler, and I have noticed more students requiring their inhalers at this time.




